Car Park

If you are planning to bring a car to the Rally please do not park it within Chemistry Farm as parking is limited & we wish this to be kept clear for stall holders and, more importantly, Rally vehicles and emergency vehicles. If you do need a car parked at The Farm please ask the permission of a Rally official and ensure a name and contact number is displayed in the windscreen. Additional parking is to be found at the Country Park car park close to Chemistry Farm.

Annual Boat Rally – Whitchurch Arm, Llangollen Canal Annually in September

Conditions of Entry *(please retain for your records)*

1. Mooring allocated on arrival
2. Toilets must not be discharged into the Waterway. There are no facilities on-site. Please arrive with water tanks full and sewage tanks empty.
3. Larger boats arriving via Grindley Brook will need to pass the arm and wind to enter the junction.
4. All details given on this form are correct at the time of entry and will be honoured at the gathering of boats. The entry covers the boats name – no refunds will be made for cancellation or non-attendance.
5. A plaque will be given to all craft entering and attending the Rally
6. The named boat must have current licences, including trading licence where required
7. Third party cover to the value of £1,000,000 (one million pounds sterling) must be held throughout the event.
8. You must abide by the directions of any officers at the event appointed by the organisers, and with any Health and Safety and similar applicable regulations.
9. The Harbour Master reserves the right to allocate moorings at his discretion
10. Waterways bylaws must be observed.
11. The organisers cannot be held responsible for any damage to persons or property however caused.
12. The ruling of the Rally Manager on all matters in final
13. The Harbour Master reserves the right to remove any boat from its mooring prior to and/or during the gathering if, in the Harbour Masters opinion, the need arises.
14. Anyone leaving their boat unattended prior to the Rally should not use chains in case the craft needs to be moved
15. The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry without cause assigned
16. Please be aware of the health risks attached to boating, especially Weils Disease.
17. Information on this form may in whole or in part be recorded on a computer in accordance with current data protection legislation. All data recorded under your name may be inspected on application to the Entries Manager.
18. All entrants must sign their entry form to show they agree to comply with and abide by the printed conditions.
